

Assembly Instructions for the Basket



Materials Needed

- Connect+ Small Basket (2 end pieces)
- 4 Basket Connector Rods
- 4 Phillips Screws (long)
- 8 M4x10mm Screws (short)
- Connect+ latch attachment
- Basket plate
- Basket lining and cargo net
- Phillips Screwdriver
- End Piece Connector for Rift (included only for Rift models)
- Ride1Up Hex Key Set (provided with bike)

STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS

Step 1: Assemble the Basket Frame

- 1. Insert the four black rods into one side of the basket.
- 2. Place the other half of the basket on top, ensuring it is fully attached.

Step 2: Secure the Basket Frame

- 1. Twist the four rods to align the holes properly before inserting the bolts
- 2. Take M4 (short) screws and screw them into the rod inserts of the basket using a hex key.



Step 3: Install the Connect+ Attachment

- 1. See figure one for reference on proper construction
- 2. Place the Connect+ latch attachment inside the basket to rest on top of the 4 tabs of the basket. The orientation of the Connect+ latch is up to the user's preference and will determine the positioning of the small basket on the bike.
- 3. Place the black basket plate over the Connect+ attachment tabs, inside the constructed basket, and align the 4 holes
- 4. Take the four long screws and insert them through the tab inserts and thread screws to ensure all three pieces (basket frame, Connect+ Latch and basket plate) are connected.

Note for Rift Models: Prior to installation, remove the Connect+ end connector piece located towards the back of the Connect+ Latch. Use a Phillips screwdriver to replace with the Rift-specific end connector included with your basket to ensure proper fit and alignment.



STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS

Step 4: Attach the Basket Lining and Cargo Net

- 1. Using the velcro flaps, secure the basket lining along the edge of the basket.
- 2. Attach the cargo net over the top for added security.

Step 5: Attach the Basket to Your Bike

- 1. Use the Connect+ system to attach the basket securely.
- 2. Push down until you hear a click, confirming it is locked in place.

Step 6: Removing the Basket

- 1. To remove the basket, pull the Connect+ latch located under the basket.
- 2. Lift the basket off the rack.

Final Steps & Review

- Ensure all bolts are tightened securely.
- Test the basket attachment by pulling gently to confirm it is locked in place.
